NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District, at an open public meeting held on November 12, 2024 that the Annual Budget, including all related schedules, of the Fire District for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2025 and ending December 31, 2025 is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the anticipated revenues as reflected in the Annual Budget are of sufficient amount to meet all proposed expenditures/expenses and all covenants, terms and provisions as stipulated in the Fire District's outstanding debt obligations, capital lease arrangements, service contracts, and other pledged agreements; and

- Increase of \$100 in fire hydrant rentals due to increase in prices.
- Increase of \$20,000 in insurance due to increase in prices.
- 6) Decrease of \$12,000 in maintenance repairs due to less anticipated need in the upcoming year.
- Increase of \$2,000 in utilities due to increased costs.
- Increase of \$230 in membershups, dues, and subscriptions due to increased costs.
- Fire official increase of \$8,000 due to additional hours provided to serve surrounding areas.
- 10) Capital outlays are expected to decrease to offset other various budget increases.
- 11) Debt service decreased due to final payment being in the prior year.
- 12) Increase of \$4,000 in office expenses is due to a change in provider for the new reporting system.
- 13) Increase of \$26,000 in equipment (appropriation offset with revenues) is due to dedicated Uniform Safety Act funds being used for implementation of the new reporting system and upgrade of the Knox Box system.


