WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as presented for adoption reflects each item of revenue and appropriation in the same amount and title as set forth in the introduced and approved budget, including all amendments thereto, if any, which have been approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services; and

WHEREAS, the adopted budget is in compliance with the Property Tax Levy Cap Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.44 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as presented for adoption reflects Total Revenues of \$638,000.00 which includes amount to be raised by taxation of \$467,000.00, and Total Appropriations of \$638,000.00; and

WHEREAS, an election shall be held annually on the third Saturday of February (only if required) in each established fire district to determine the amount to be raised by taxation for the ensuing year;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District at an open public meeting held on December 10, 2024 that the Annual Budget of the Fire District for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2025 and ending December 31, 2025 is hereby adopted and, shall constitute appropriations for the purposes stated and authorization of Total Revenues of \$638,000.00, which includes amount to be raised by taxation of \$467,000.00, and Total Appropriations of \$638,000.00; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Annual Budget as presented for adoption reflects each item of revenue and appropriation in the same amount and title as set forth in the introduced and approved budget, including all amendments thereto, if any, which have been approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that an annual election shall be held on the third Saturday of February (only if required) to determine the amount to be raised by taxation for the ensuing year. The results of which shall be subsequently certified to the Division and the Municipal Assessor.







For the period of December 11, 2024 through December 9, 2025

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AND IMPLEMENTING A PROGRAM TO CHARGE MITIGATION RATES FOR THE DEPLOYMENT OF EMERGENCY AND NON-EMERGENCY SERVICES BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR SERVICES PROVIDED/RENDERED FOR THE FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP FIRE DISTRICT # 1 OF HUNTERDON COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the emergency services response activity to incidents continues to increase each year; Environmental Protection requirements involving equipment and training, and Homeland Security regulations involving equipment and training, creating additional demands on all operational aspects of the fire department services; and

WHEREAS, the fire department has investigated different methods to maintain a high level of quality of emergency and non-emergency service capability throughout times of constantly increasing service demands, where maintaining an effective response by the fire department decreases the costs of incidents to insurance carriers, businesses, and individuals through timely and effective management of emergency situations, saving lives and reducing property and environmental damage; and

WHEREAS, the Board of fire commissioners of the FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP FIRE DISTRICT # 1 OF HUNTERDON COUNTY. desires to implement a fair and equitable procedure by which to collect said mitigation rates and shall establish a billing system in accordance with applicable laws, regulations and guidelines; Now, Therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS OF THE FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP FIRE DISTRICT # 1 OF HUNTERDON COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP FIRE DISTRICT # 1 OF HUNTERDON COUNTY. shall initiate mitigation rates for the delivery of emergency and non-emergency services by the fire department for personnel, supplies and equipment to the scene of emergency and non-emergency incidents as listed in "EXHIBIT A". The mitigation rates shall be based on actual costs of the services and that which is usual, customary and reasonable as shown in "EXHIBIT A", which may include any services, personnel, supplies, and equipment and with baselines established by addendum to this document.

SECTION 2: A claim shall be filed to the responsible party(s) through their insurance carrier. In some circumstances, the responsible party(s) will be billed directly.

SECTION 3: The FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP FIRE DISTRICT # 1 OF HUNTERDON COUNTY may make rules or regulations and from time to time may amend, revoke, or add rules and regulations, as they may deem necessary or expedient in respect to billing for these mitigation rates or the collection thereof.

SECTION 4: This resolution shall take effect at the date of adoption.

SECTION 5: Mitigation rates will only apply to persons who are not a tax payer or a resident of Franklin Township Hunterdon County.

EXHIBIT A

MITIGATION RATES BASED ON PER HOUR

The mitigation rates below are average "billing levels", and are typical for the incident responses listed, however, when a claim is submitted, it will be itemized and based on the actual services provided.

MOTOR VEHICLE INCIDENTS

Level 1 - \$435.00

Provide hazardous materials assessment and scene stabilization. This will be the most common "billing level". This occurs almost every time the fire department responds to an accident/incident.

Level 2 - \$495.00

Includes Level 1 services as well as clean up and material used (sorbents) for hazardous fluid clean up and disposal. We will bill at this level if the fire department has to clean up any gasoline or other automotive fluids that are spilled as a result of the accident/incident.

Level 3 - CAR FIRE - \$605.00

Provide scene safety, fire suppression, breathing air, rescue tools, hand tools, hose, tip use, foam, structure protection, and clean up gasoline or other automotive fluids that are spilled as a result of the accident/incident.

ADD-ON SERVICES:

Extrication - \$1,305.00

Includes heavy rescue tools, ropes, airbags, cribbing etc. This charge will be added if the fire department has to free/remove anyone from the vehicle(s) using any equipment. We will not bill at this level if the patient is simply unconscious and fire department is able to open the door to access the patient. This level is to be billed only if equipment is deployed.

Creating a Landing Zone - \$400.00

Includes Air Care (multi-engine company response, mutual aid, helicopter). We will bill at this level any time a helicopter landing zone is created and/or is utilized to transport the patient(s).

Itemized Response: You have the option to bill each incident as an independent event with custom mitigation rates, for each incident using, itemized rates deemed usual, customary and reasonable (UCR). These incidents will be billed, itemized per apparatus, per personnel, plus products and equipment used.

ADDITIONAL TIME ON-SCENE

Fire Apparatus billed at \$400 per hour.

Miscellaneous equipment billed at \$300.

HAZMAT

Level 1 - \$700.00

Basic Response: Claim will include engine response, first responder assignment, perimeter establishment, evacuations, set-up and command.

ADDITIONAL TIME ON-SCENE (for all levels of service)

Fire Apparatus billed at \$400 per hour.

Miscellaneous equipment billed at \$300

WATER INCIDENTS

Level 1

Basic Response: Claim will include engine response, first responder assignment, perimeter establishment, evacuations, first responder set-up and command, scene safety and investigation (including possible patient contact, hazard control). This will be the most common "billing level". This occurs almost every time the fire department responds to a water incident.

Billed at \$400 plus \$50 per hour, per rescue person.

PLANE OR SPECIAL RESCUE

Itemized Response: Each incident will be billed with custom mitigation rates deemed usual, customary and reasonable (UCR). These incidents will be billed, itemized per apparatus per hour, per trained rescue person per hour, plus rescue products used.

Minimum billed \$400 for the first response vehicle plus \$50 per rescue person. Additional rates of \$400 per hour per response vehicle and \$50 per hour per rescue person.

MISCELLANEOUS / ADDITIONAL TIME ON-SCENE

Fire Apparatus billed at \$400 per hour.

Miscellaneous equipment billed at \$300.

MITIGATION RATE NOTES

The mitigation rates above are average "billing levels", and are typical for the incident responses listed, however, when a claim is submitted, it will be itemized and based on the actual services provided.

These average mitigation rates were determined by itemizing costs for a typical run (from the time a fire apparatus leaves the station until it returns to the station) and are based on the actual costs, using amortized schedules for apparatus (including useful life, equipment, repairs, and maintenance) and labor rates (an average department's "actual personnel expense" and not just a firefighter's basic wage). The actual personnel expense includes costs such as wages, retirement, benefits, workers comp, insurance, etc.

LATE FEES

If the invoice is not paid within 90 days, a Late Charge of 10% of the invoice, as well as 1.5% per month, as well as the actual cost of the collections, will be assessed to the responsible party.

WHEREAS, the FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP FIRE DISTRICT #1 OF HUNTERDON COUNTY, is established and operating pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-70 to -105.1; and,

WHEREAS, the FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP FIRE DISTRICT #1 OF HUNTERDON COUNTY, is authorized pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:34-6.2(b)(3) to use alternative procurement methods by entering into nationally recognized cooperative agreement; and,

WHEREAS, Houston-Galveston Area Counsel is a regional planning commission and political subdivision of the State of Texas operating under Chapter 391, Texas Local Government Code; and,

WHEREAS, Houston-Galveston Area Counsel is authorized to contract with eligible entities for the purchase of goods and services; and,

WHEREAS, Houston-Galveston Area Counsel has instituted a cooperative purchasing program under which it contracts with eligible entities; and,

WHEREAS, the FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP FIRE DISTRICT #1 OF HUNTERDON COUNTY desires to contract with Houston-Galveston Area Counsel;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Resolved that:

1. The PRESIDENT of FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP FIRE DISTRICT #1 OF HUNTERDON COUNTY is hereby authorized to execute complete any necessary paperwork required to enter into an inter-local agreement the Houston-Galveston Area Counsel;
2. All activities under this agreement will be in accordance with all applicable rules, regulations, ordinances and laws in effect or promulgated during the term of the agreement;
3. The initial period of the agreement shall be for the balance of the Calendar year;
4. The agreement shall thereafter automatically be renewed annually for each succeeding fiscal year, provided that such renewal shall not have the effect of extending the period in which any payments are due under any contract entered into for the purchase of fire apparatus pursuant to this agreement;

5. The purchase of any product will be in accordance with procedures established by the Houston-Galveston Area Council and in accordance with the Laws of the State of New Jersey;
6. Any payments made pursuant to the agreement will be in accordance with procedures established by the Houston-Galveston Area Council;
7. The agreement may be amended only by a written amendment executed in accordance with procedures established by the Houston-Galveston Area Council;
8. The agreement may be terminated by either party at any time upon thirty (30) days written notice by certified mail to the other party to this agreement.

RESOLUTION 2024-30

This Participation Agreement is between Sourcewell and Franklin Township Fire District No. 1 to provide access to Sourcewell's Cooperative Purchasing Program. Sourcewell's Board of Directors has approved these terms and conditions through operation of this intergovernmental Participation Agreement. Participating Entity approves this Agreement upon registration with Sourcewell.

Section 1: Authority

1.1 Sourcewell is a service cooperative established by Minn. Stat. § 123A.21 as a local unit of government pursuant to the Minn. Const. art. XII, sec. 3.

1.2 Sourcewell is authorized to provide a Cooperative Purchasing Program by Minn. Stat. § 123A.21, subd. 7(23) to Participating Entities.

1.3 Sourcewell's cooperative purchasing master agreements are offered through Minn. Stat. § 471.59 and this Participation Agreement. The Sourcewell Board of Directors has approved these participation terms, and Sourcewell is authorized to enter this interlocal or joint powers agreement with an eligible Participating Entity through this Participation Agreement.

1.4 Participation in Sourcewell's Cooperative Purchasing Program is open to eligible Participating Entities. A Participating Entity is any eligible entity registering with Sourcewell, including: any government unit, including a state, city, county, town, village, school district, political subdivision of any state, federally recognized Indian tribe, any agency of the United States, any instrumentality of a governmental unit, any other entity as defined in Minn. Stat. § 471.59 Subd. 1(b).

1.5 Participating Entity and Sourcewell agree this Participation Agreement is for the purpose of allowing access to available Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program master agreements with awarded Suppliers.

1.6 Participating Entity represents, through an authorized signatory, it is eligible for participation as defined in this Agreement.

Section 2: General Terms

2.1 Sourcewell will make its Cooperative Purchasing Program available to Participating Entity. Sourcewell master agreements are provided to Participating Entity "as is." Sourcewell makes no representation as to warranties of quality, merchantability, or fitness for a particular purpose for any purchase through a Supplier. Participation in the Program is voluntary and nonexclusive.

2.2 To purchase from Sourcewell master agreements, Participating Entity and Supplier will execute a Transaction Document(s) as mutually agreed. Participating Entity will be responsible for all aspects of its

purchase, including ordering, inspecting, acceptance, payment, and any other DocuSign Envelope ID: 699C2238-08BA-4EAB-97EC-0B6E3F2CA3B7 2 Effective January 1, 2024 material terms as negotiated directly with Supplier.

2.3 The Parties to this Agreement will adhere to all applicable laws concerning the procurement in its respective jurisdiction.

2.4 Access to the Cooperative Purchasing Program is effective upon the date of Franklin Township Fire District No. 1's completed registration. The Agreement will remain in effect until canceled by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party.

2.5 Each party agrees that it is responsible for its acts and the results thereof, to the extent authorized by law, and will not be responsible for the acts of the other Party.

2.6 There will be no financial remunerations by or obligations upon Participating Entity for participation in Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program.

2.7 Sourcewell's Cooperative Purchasing Program master agreements will be procured in compliance with Minnesota law and the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program.

2.8 The records and documents related to this this Agreement are subject to the Minnesota Data Practices Act, Minnesota Statutes Chapter 13.

This resolution and the notice of award of contract shall be available for public inspection.


